P D/B 2

1st Shutt's Donnadoon Starlight – two attractive young red pups who both had positive attributes, including dark almond eyes, well proportioned heads and super coats. This bitch was my winner on her length of sternum and more compact feet. However she needs to overcome her lack of interest in moving though the strides I saw were of good length.B.P.

2nd Oxley's Lokmadi Rio Bravo at Dinkidax – as above this lad also had good body proportions and much more confident on the move. Just standing a bit flat footed at the moment . Both had length to neck.

J D/B 1

1st Oxley's Dinkidax Lily Grace – black and tan, not heavily coated,with equidistant muzzle and skull, reach to neck and enough width in front and length of keel. Excellent feet, larger in front and liked her rear angles. Just out of puppy and rising a little behind today. Moved well.

PG D/B 1

1st Livingston's Rarewood April Star – black and cream bitch in beautiful flat silky coat, just a bit toyish in head for me. Could do with more length to neck but excellent length to sternum and ribbing, short strong loin. Moved actively and freely.

O D/B 3

1st Paskins, Dinkidax Sandrayanna at Kindeace – this mature red male is a real houndy boy ,excellent flat coat , reach of neck, topline held on the stack and on the move. Prominent prosternum, length to keel, short loin and balanced angulation. Moved true both fore and aft,on strong compact feet, with activity and striding out. B.O.B.

2nd Oxley's Dinkidax Cyenna Satin JW – feminine red in beautiful coat and condition, super topline and also moved well, just lost out on slightly rounder eye shape I felt. R.B.O.B.

3rd Shutt's Stargazer of Donnadoon

Miniature Smooth Haired

P D/B 1

1ST Fossett's Lockmadi Peggy Sue for Brysdax – lovely shaded red with dense close well fitted coat, though maybe slightly throaty.Attractive houndy head with almond eye and I liked her wrap around front and reach to neck. Pleasing topline and underline and decent bone. Moved actively and with purpose. B.P. and R.B.O.B.

J D/B 4(1)

1st Nicol's Chillis Sweet Girl – pretty red, no mistaking her sex, with good length to muzzle and skull, and also reach to neck .Correct, well held topline, good proportions and strong , hammy rear. Moved out with activity.

2nd Oxley's Dinkidax India Spice – black and tan of taller type, and so attractive, super dense close jacket, just needing more forechest for me.

3rd Livinston's Nordham Major Tom

PG D/B 1

1ST Taylor's Debbiejay Magical Flo –red with well proportioned head,could do with a bit more to neck but well enough off for bone. Super well fitted close coat and a happy active mover holding her topline on the move, though not quite so well on the stack.

O D/B 2

1st Herrington's Kathington Just By Chance JW – feminine and appealing red bitch of good shape, pleasing topline and underline and 2 to 1 proportions. Balanced angulation too. Head of equidistant muzzle and skull, almond eye shape, elegant neck. Close dense coat, well enough off for bone and a happy, confident mover with good stride. B.O.B.

2nd Shutt's Donnadoon Dream Dust – substantial forefront and pleasing head, another good coat and well fitting skin. Just inclined to put right hind leg in close on the move.

Miniature Wire Haired

P D/B 2

1st Livingston's Thargelion Boromir – very appealing red dog, who although obviously a bit bigger than ideal, otherwise pleased for overall outline and proportions. Good muzzle to skull ratio, lovely dark almond eye and super harsh jacket. Length to ribbing and balanced angulation, trotted out with stride and purpose. B.P and B.O.B.

2nd Beardsley's Kaffooi Army of One – brindle bitch with balanced but slightly upright angles. Pretty head with good proportions, reach to neck and moved well, just rather high on leg for me. R.B.O.B.

Long Haired

P D/B 3

1st Paskins' Bronia Final Kiss at Bronia – black and tan, so beautifully furnished in gleaming coat of correct texture, feminine balanced head and reach of neck. Super frame and well off for bone, strong feet. Lovely sweeping underline and topline held level on the stack and on the move. Moved true fore and aft, freely and striding out. B.P.

2nd Paskins' Kindeace Scarlett O' Hara – red bitch, again in lovely flat coat. Strongly made and with great length to ribbing, short loin. Moved freely just inclined to be turn her front feet out a bit more than ideal for me.

J D/B 2(1)

1st Paskins' Cedavoch It's Taboo at Kindeace – red male, presents a handsome picture. Dark almond eye, strong head but well set on to neck, great topline and with balanced angulation fore and aft. Pleasing body proportions. Large compact feet, flat gleaming coat, presented beautifully. Active, free and happy on the move. R.B.O.B.

PG D/B 4(1)

1st Chapman's Melminds Marina Diamonds – typey ladylike red bitch of good size, pleasing head balance but perhaps could do with stronger underjaw. Great reach of neck and strong bone, great feet. Underline flows and in flat coat of good texture. Moved true and with vigour.

2nd Cole's Andromeda Galaxy – another feminine bitch with equidistant muzzle and skull, though a wee bit heavy in flew. Decent shape and overall proportions, wrap around front and good coat. Could lose a little weight to advantage.

3rd Hagan, Borsuk and Fossett's Baltic Legacy via Amberteckel

O D/B 6

1st Cole's Pennywise of Derry – this dog caught my eye as soon as he came into the ring, he really has a gentle presence. Pleased for size and has the most beautiful flat shaded red coat. Lovely dark almond eye, skull and muzzle of equal length, leading into a good reach of neck flowing into a level topline and excellent 2 to 1 proportions. In complete balance and it showed in his movement, free, true and active B.O.B.

2nd Hagan and Borsuk's Ir Ch Badamtam's Via Baltica at Follypaws (Imp Fin) – black and tan veteran and sire of above, so active and positive in his movement. Again his proportions really pleased as did his well shaped head and eye. Lines flowed and decent bone, good coat. B.V.I.B. and R.B.V.I.S., congratulations!

Wire Haired

P D/B 1

1ST McPherson and Paterson's Brumberhill Mr Wilks – brindle male in wonderful harsh jacket and of good size. Masculine head with matching length of muzzle and skull and lovely almond eye. Great bone and feet of big enough size, though could maybe do to be slightly tighter in front. Excellent ribbing and short loin. Moved well though not always completely accurate behind today in his class. B.P., B.O.B. and Puppy Group 4, well done!

J D/B 1

1ST Baxter's Hotwire Just A Little Bit – happy and attractive dark brindle with such a pretty head, width in front with plenty heart room and smooth underline. A little flat footed, though enough bone. Harsh coat coming on well and moved with wagging tail, co-operating well with her young handler.

PG D/B 2

1ST Baxter's Hotwire Twist and Sprout – 2 rather different types, both with positive attributes. Red bitch with a houndy head, lovely eye shape . Maybe slightly longer cast but good length to ribs, really hammy quarters, decent outline. Moved true and actively and good jacket.

2nd Eldred's Bramalodge Amiety at Derdledash – brindle bitch of slightly leggier proportions in super harsh jacket. Lovely eye shape and houndy head, just seems a bit stuffy in neck and shoulder. Well off for bone and moved freely and true.

O D/B 4(1)

1ST Baxter's Cishelvine August Breeze with Hotwire – veteran dark brindle characterful bitch with an attractive, feminine, balanced head. Pleasing shape and balance ,with well held topline and flowing underline. Strong bone, though feet could be tighter. Harsh coat and a free and true mover. R.B.O.B. and B.V.I.B.

2ND Stiles Cishelvine Sea Spray – mature red bitch of good proportions and balanced head. In her underclothes but of good texture. A bit upright in shoulder but length to ribbing and topline held on the move and when stacked.

3rd Baxter's Cishelvine Red Admiral.
